Tarkett Employees Give to Three Palm Desert Charities

SOLON, Ohio (February 17, 2017) — Tarkett, a worldwide leader in innovative and sustainable flooring and sports surface solutions, sponsored a volunteer day for employees while visiting the Palm Springs community. As part of Tarkett's annual sales meeting, which was held in Palm Desert, Feb. 14 – 17, Tarkett employees gave back to the community by completing projects at Coachella Valley Horse Rescue, Shelter from the Storm, and two locations of Boys and Girls Clubs of Coachella Valley — the President Gerald R. Ford Clubhouse in La Quinta and Frank Foster Palmer Powell Family Clubhouse in Coachella.

Company volunteers completed a number of needed projects, including:

- Building a porch ramp, porch cover and viewing area and installing two air conditioning units at Coachella Valley Horse Rescue
- Painting a number of surfaces and equipment, including murals, and installing flooring at La Quinta Boys and Girls Club of Coachella Valley
- Repairing and refurbishing landscaping, a playground and office spaces at Shelter from the Storm
- Updating landscaping with native plants, painting fences, the parking lot and basketball court markings, and installing new benches and basketball goals.

Additionally, the team is placing a couple dozen Kimball Office chairs at the Boys and Girls Clubs of Coachella Valley — a donation from the company.

"Corporate social responsibility is at the heart of our Tarkett strategy and values," said Glen Morrison, president and CEO, Tarkett North America.
