



VOCs and Air Quality

We share your responsibility to protect air quality in new office environments: all our Tandus modular carpets have the Green Label Plus certification which result from our exhaustive efforts to eliminate harmful VOCs in our product design and manufacturing process. Our Tandus modular carpet with PVC backing is also 100% phthalate-free.

Antimicrobials

Tandus modular carpet is designed to deliver maximum protection against mold and mildew without the use of hazardous antimicrobial pesticides, which can be inhaled and create adverse health effects. Using antimicrobial treatment on the carpet will only be temporary and will favor the bacteria resistance in the middle and long term, which is a major public health threat.

We guarantee a 15-year warranty product without relying on unnecessary chemicals.

Our carpet benefits from Eco-Ensure technology: a fluorine-free and PFAS – free soil protection to avoid any stains on the carpet. In addition, we recommend to follow the maintenance instructions (see pages 180-183) of our carpet tiles and to clean as soon as possible any stains.

Fire Safety

All Tandus modular carpet are tested in independent and certified laboratories to meet Class 1 rating on flammability.

Recycled Content

We have partnered with third party company to recycle empty wine bottles into our Ecobond Backing. Up to 60% of the Ecobond secondary backing is made of recycled materials.

In some Tandus collections, we use the ECONYL® yarn which is made from 100% regenerated nylon including discarded fishing nets. Tarkett supports the Healthy Seas initiative, that aims to remove waste from the sea, in particular fishing nets and recycling them into regenerated yarn.

Maximum flexibility

Tandus carpet tiles installed with TarkettTAPE can easily be removed. Because the tape sticks to the tile, and not to the floor, you can change your carpet tiles when needed or return them to us for recycling at the end of use. TarkettTAPE leaves no traces on the subfloor, the tiles all stick solidly, creating a 'floating' floor that stays in place as long as needed. TarkettTAPE sticks straight from the roll, whereby installers find it quick, clean and easy to use. It has very low VOC-emissions, no odour, and no drying time. With these specifications, TarkettTAPE contributes perfectly to your sustainability goals.

Fast and Easy Installation

Each tape unit measures ca. 8 x 10 cm with notched perforations between each unit. There are 324 units per roll with a coverage area of ca. 80 m²/roll installed with 50 x 50 cm tiles. Packaged from 1 to 16 rolls per box with a minimum order quantity of one roll. The tape unit is centered at the corner of the tile as to engage the inner section of the two adjacent and one opposing tile corners.

Carpet installation

Introduction

You can rest reassured that on leaving the factory, Tandus carpet tiles fully meet all the specifications described on the product documentation. But Tandus Carpet tiles will only come to life once installed. Therefore, it is of great importance that the instructions below are followed very carefully. Although Tandus guarantees the accuracy of their advice, it cannot be held responsible or warrant carpet tiles if these floor preparation and installation procedures are not followed. If you have any questions concerning the proper installation and use of Tandus modular carpet, please contact your sales representative.

All Tandus modular carpet should be inspected before commencing fitting. Make sure that the quality, colour, size, pattern, etc. correspond to your order prior to installation. Do not install Tandus modular carpet if any problems are noted.

Preparing the subfloor

These instructions cannot cover all subfloor conditions. It is the responsibility of the installation contractor to make certain the subfloor is properly prepared prior to starting the installation.

1 Room conditions

The area in which Tandus modular carpet is to be installed (including the subfloor) should be between 18°C-32°C (65°F-90°F) for at least 72 hours prior to, during and after the installation. All Tandus carpet tiles and installation materials should be stored at this temperature for at least 48 hours prior to installation.

Underfloor heating compatibility

Tandus modular carpet can be installed over surfaces that never exceed 50°C (122°F). In cold regions with heated floors, the heat may be turned off every weekend or every night. With underfloor heating system, do not install the tiles too tight and do not use a tool for hitting the tiles together.

2 Subfloor inspection

All subfloors should be leveled to assure good installation. Concrete subfloors should be flat within 1 mm per 1 meter (or 1/8" per 10 feet) and should be troweled smooth, if



necessary. Cracks, holes and depressions can be filled by using a good grade of cement, concrete or fortified patching material. Do not install the carpet over loose tile (VAT, VCT or others). The subfloor must be structurally sound and dry prior to installation.

Excessive subfloor moisture or high subfloor pH alkalinity can cause product failure, especially on concrete subfloor.



For all Tandus modular carpet, the maximum allowable amount of Moisture Vapor Emission Rate from the subfloor is 1.36 kg/24 hours/92.9 sqm (or 3.0 lbs/24hours/ 1000 sq. feet); the acceptable **pH range is 7.0 to 9.0**; if performing In-Situ, the maximum allowable Relative Humidity is 80%. Please note that relative humidity above 65% will slow down primer and adhesive set or dry times: humidity of the room should be less than 65% for 24 hours prior to installation.

3 Subfloor cleaning

Clean the subfloor of all excess concrete spots, solid debris or paint spots using suitable scraping methods. Completely remove all wax, dirt, grease, paints or old adhesives (especially cutback or emulsion). Any curing chemical treatment used on subfloors must be chemically and physically compatible with our Tandus modular carpet and adhesive systems. Do not use solvents, any chemical adhesive removers, oil-based or silicone based sweeping compound to clean the subfloor. Sweep and vacuum the floor after patching and debris removal. Make sure all perimeter areas are clean. Smooth, nonporous floors should be damp mopped prior to product installation.







Installation of Tandus modular carpet

1 Prepare your plan - this step is very important


Determine the lay direction of the carpet based on building design and installation efficiencies. Detailed installation instructions should be conveyed to installers to meet the designer's intention.

Measure the length and width of the room. Locate the first centerline in the installation area by marking the center point of two opposing, parallel walls. Snap a white (not blue or red) chalk line between the two center marks. Snap a second, perpendicular chalk line at the mid-point of this line (use a 3-4-5 triangle method to make sure the second line is perpendicular to the first). Check the distance from each centerline to its parallel wall and determine how many tiles will be required (depending on the size of the carpet to install). Shift the line as needed (in a parallel direction) to balance the width of the border tiles (tiles against the wall). Border tiles, where possible, should not be less than half of a tile.

2 Apply the adhesive

Pressure Sensitive Adhesives approved by Tandus must be used in a full spread mode. Please check with Tarkett sales representative for approved adhesives. Do not use adhesive over raised panel flooring until all of the electrical work is completed.

Apply the adhesive with a short nap paint roller. Do not allow the wet adhesive to puddle, but allow the adhesive to set and dry prior to installation tiles (approximately 40 min). Adhesive is set when it dries clear and will not transfer to the hand when touched. Tiles should be installed immediately after the adhesive has dried. Never step in the adhesive when it is wet or dry. Any adhesive you get on the yarn will be difficult to remove and will likely collect dirt.




3 Install the carpet tiles

Directional arrows are printed on the back of all tiles. Determine in which direction the arrow should be placed in accordance with the designer's intentions (quarter turn, monolithic, ashlar, etc.).

Start from the intersection point in the center of the floor and install the first line of tiles along the first centerline. Install the second line of tiles along the perpendicular centerline. Keep all the tiles exactly on the chalk lines. Fit the tiles snugly next to each other by sliding them into place. Do not force the tiles together, let them loosely lay. Remember not to trap face yarn between or under tile edges.

Continue to install the tiles in a stair step or pyramid pattern starting from the intersection point. Check to make sure the tiles are properly aligned at the edges during installation. When applying additional adhesive to the floor, do not roll wet adhesive onto the yarn of tiles that are installed. If small variations in the tile sizes start to make the installation skewed, use the straight edge to cut a sliver of the backing off the tiles without cutting into the yarn to make them straighten back up.

When reaching the walls, place a damaged tile face down, in the dried adhesive, along the wall. Take another full tile and butt it against the wall allowing it to fall on top of the cut tile with the yarn face down on top of the cut tile - this will keep you from getting adhesive on the yarn of the tile you wish to install. Use a metal straight edge to line up the size of the tile with the closest tiles. Cut through the backing along the straight edge. Remove the cut tile and save it for the next cut. When you flip the tile back over, the machine cut edge will be against the installed carpet and the hand-cut edge will be against the wall. Provide transition strips on all exposed tile edges.



Introduction

With a simple, systematic and cost-effective carpet maintenance plan you can protect your investment and reap the rewards for years to come. Tandus carpet tiles are made with industry-leading materials that help to mask soil and other debris that can make carpets look old and dirty. Proper maintenance can extend the life and appearance of your carpet, thus saving money. Tarkett aims to design solutions following the Cradle to Cradle® principles, including the maintenance of our flooring. Maintenance is an integral part of flooring and the C2C principles need to be integrated into the maintenance programme.

Tandus recommends a three-steps maintenance programme with daily maintenance, periodic maintenance and deep cleaning. The main part of the maintenance programme is covered by vacuum cleaning and spot removal by the use of water. The frequency of maintenance depends on colour, the intensity of use, area and grade of representation.

Preventive measures

The easiest way to clean carpet is to REDUCE the need to clean carpet! Prevention is always easier than fixing problems. One preventive measure to take is to install dirt barrier zones with scraping and absorbing effect to all entrances, with sufficient length and starting outside the building. Doing this is essential to keep the dirt outside which represent up to 90% of the soil load. All matting must be kept clean to make sure they do not become a source of soil: thoroughly vacuum them daily and check them weekly to ensure a clean mat at all times. Another measure is to use chair mats to prevent soil from being ground into the carpet fibers which leads to dirty, matted carpet. Another important preventive measure is selecting the right flooring, in colour, pattern and structure for all parts of your building, taking into account the traffic and use of each area.

Detergents and cleaning aids

A wide range of detergents and cleaning aids are available for carpet cleaning and maintenance. In addition to equipment, proper cleaning solutions are important. Choosing the right cleaning solution is essential: it must be safe, non-toxic, not contain optical brighteners, it should have a pH between 4 and 9 and should not leave sticky or oily residue when dry. To test it: prepare the solution as instructed and pour into a shallow pan. Place in direct sunlight and allow to evaporate. If a sticky or oily residue is left, DO NOT use on carpets.

Note: Optical brighteners should NEVER be used on your carpeting. The use of optical brighteners may void your warranty.

For the best results always follow the instructions on the container. It is also important to first test cleaning agents on a concealed part of the floor for colourfastness.

Tandus maintenance programme in 3 steps

STEP 1 - Daily maintenance & stain removal

Routine/daily maintenance is a combination of vacuum cleaning and spot removal, carried out as often as needed for the different zones within your building. Effective vacuum cleaning is an essential part of a proper maintenance programme to keep soiling to a minimum. Dirt barrier zones and heavy traffic areas, such as lobbies and hallways, should be intensively vacuumed on a daily basis. Other areas, such as offices and board rooms, can be vacuumed daily based on visual inspection with a thorough overall vacuuming at least once a week. For best results Tarkett recommends heavy duty upright vacuum cleaners with a brushing action and efficient, clean filters. Additional to vacuuming, regular spot removal should take place to maintain a good appearance. Ideally spills should be removed immediately to prevent them from becoming permanent stains.

The majority of water based stains can be removed with a clean white (cotton) cloth and lukewarm water, after drying possibly treated afterwards with an appropriate carpet cleaning agent. Excessive moisture should be absorbed first (from the outside in) and rubbing and excessive use of water should be avoided.

Dried or aged stains can first be treated with a blunt object (e.g. a spoon) to remove dried residue by vacuuming. In all cases repeat treatments where required after drying until the stains are removed (always avoiding excessive rubbing).

Other (oil based) stains and chewing gum should be treated with a suitable carpet cleaning agent.

Note: Never apply a solvent based stains removal product directly onto the carpet surface. This can cause dissolution of carpet components. Always apply on a white cloth!

STEP 2 - Periodic maintenance

Periodic Maintenance takes place if the daily maintenance no longer gives the desired performing and preferably should be carried out by a specialist. Generally, this periodic maintenance is carried out 1 to 2 times per year, depending on the specific needs of your building and the different areas within. From the many cleaning methods available, Tandus recommends two options: crystal dry cleaning and dry compound cleaning. Be assured that the product used does not cause re-soiling. Always vacuum before carrying out either of these methods.

The crystal dry cleaning (Encapsulation) method is a low moisture procedure that involves spraying an encapsulation liquid solution on the carpet, gently brushing these into the carpet piles and, after a drying period of approximately one hour, vacuuming thoroughly. The crystals effectively encapsulate any soil which can then be removed by vacuum cleaning. The main benefits of this method include ongoing access to the room or area that is being treated, a reduced treatment time and colourless residue (if any). For the best results it is very important to use the proper type of crystals.

The method of dry compound cleaning is similar to crystal dry cleaning with a few differences: the 'dry' powder (it can feel moist) is spread onto the carpet by hand and mechanically brushed in. Extra attention needs to be paid to the full removal of any residue (powder and soil) as it is not colourless. With this method, you can use the area during the maintenance procedure also.

When using either method, make sure to first test them on a concealed part of the floor for the colourfastness of the carpet.

STEP 3 - Deep cleaning

Proper routine maintenance on a daily/weekly basis, supported by periodic maintenance, keeps the aesthetics and performance of your carpet flooring at a satisfactory level for a long period. Over time your carpet may accumulate ingrained soil deeply embedded in the pile and specialist restorative maintenance will need to be carried out. This should be taken place on advice and in consultation with a specialist, in accordance to the maintenance plan. Tandus recommends the method of **hot water extraction** to deep clean your carpet. This must always be preceded by intensive vacuum cleaning and possibly also spot removal or pre-spraying to loosen stain residues.

Hot water extraction is a wet deep cleaning method using a pre-spray and a special machine. After vacuuming the carpet surface, an appropriate cleaning agent must be sprayed at the soiled carpet. After that the machine injects clean warm water deep into the carpet to take up the soil and removes the resulting dirty mix of water and used cleaning agent with a built-in vacuum system and rinse the carpet surface. This combination is the most effective method. It allows more time for chemical action and neutralizing the cleaning chemical in the rinse. It is very important not to use excessive amount of water to avoid over-wetting the carpet. It is therefore recommended to get a specialist (carpet) cleaning company carry out this type of maintenance. Furthermore it is very important to make sure the floor is given enough time to dry before it is used again (generally 1-2 days).





15 years warranty


Tandus modular carpet with nylon face fiber are covered by a limited warranty issued by Tandus Asia against:

- Excessive surface wear
- Edge ravel
- Zippering
- Resiliency loss of backing
- Delamination of the secondary backing from the primary backing containing the face fiber

For a non-prorated period of fifteen (15) years from the date of manufacturer's invoice only when properly installed on correctly prepared floors using Tandus Asia approved procedures and adhesives and maintained in accordance with Tandus Asia approved maintenance and cleaning procedures.

Tandus modular carpet also carry a limited warranty against excessive static electricity during this fifteen (15) years period only when installed and maintained in accordance with Tandus Asia approved procedures. Excessive static electricity means more than 3.0 kilovolts at a relative humidity of 20% and a room temperature of 21°C.

The details of the Tandus modular carpet warranty can be provided upon request.
