





Through this process, we have: reduced our energy use; converted factories in Ohio, Sweden, and Italy to renewable energy; utilized recycled materials in our products to reduce their carbon footprint; and offset the remainder of our footprint to create a portfolio of carbon neutral

products. We have partnered on global products for our offsetting—including support of international renewable energy initiatives, and reforestation of the Peruvian Amazon. Through our support of the Tambopata National Reserve and the Bahuaja-Sorene National Park, we've helped to protect nearly 1.5 million acres and restore 10,000 acres—an action expected to avoid over four million tons of carbon emissions by 2021.

We are often asked to simplify our sustainability story. The truth is that making a positive impact on our world and its citizens is not so simple. Reducing the use of fossil fuels and incorporating recycled materials into our products can pose challenges, but Tarkett is working hard to make these improvements—because we value your health, and that of our environment.
