



A HISTORICAL INDUSTRY IN THE HEART OF THE FRENCH ARDENNES

1880

The Sommer venture began with Alfred Sommer, who founded a felt factory in the French Ardennes.

1912

His son, Roger, joined the family business bringing inventiveness, a creative flair, and a daring spirit.

1922

The factory, partially destroyed during the war, resumed its activities under the direction of his sons Pierre and François Sommer.

1953

The company's future took a whole new turn when felt and plastic were combined to create Tapiflex: a carpet with a plastic surface on a needled felt backing.

1959

Marked the birth of Tapisom, the first synthetic needled floor covering and Somvyl, a vinyl foam product, real innovations in the market.

1965



TWO PROCESSES EXIST FOR MANUFACTURING VINYL FLOORING


Calendering is an operation that consists of passing vinyl between cylinders to produce a sheet.






These two processes -calendering/coating- are combined to manufacture Omnisports; this association allows:

- Outstanding dimensional stability (<0.10%), higher than competitors' products.
- Loose laying with the **exclusive GreenLay™ method** (98% adhesive-free) of Omnisports Reference Multi-use, Active+ & Pureplay ranges.



Coating is an operation that consists of coating a base layer (calendered sheet) with one or more additional layers to give it specific mechanical properties and aesthetics.





WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO CAREFULLY SELECT A SPORTS FLOORING FOR A MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY?

A multi-purpose sports hall is used overwhelmingly for purely sporting purposes. Its floor covering must therefore comply with the requirements of the sports standard EN14904 with a minimum shock absorption of 25% for the safety of athletes.


This equipment is also likely to host non-sports events (elections, conventions, association meetings, etc.). Its floor covering must therefore also be adapted to multi-use requirements.







MULTI-PURPOSE INDEX (MPI)



Multi-use levels are determined by two essential criteria: resistance to static and rolling loads.

Tarkett Sports identifies three levels of multi-use:

MPI1

Light multi-use: tables, chairs...

Type of events: associative meetings, exams, elections...

Recommended products: Omnisports Reference Multi-use

MPI2

Intermediate multi-use: light bleachers, scissor lifts up to 2T...

Type of events: Shows, galas, receptions...

Recommended products: Lumaflex Evolution






WHAT IS A WEAR LAYER, AND HOW DO YOU CORRECTLY MEASURE ITS THICKNESS?

The wear layer is the resilient flooring's top layer. Its function is to protect the decor and guarantee a high resistance to abrasion. It prevents premature wearing and ensures the flooring's longevity. Tarkett Sports refers to the EN ISO 24340 standard to determine its thickness. It's important to keep this standard in mind when comparing different products on the market.

Omnisports floorings benefit from a minimum wear layer of 0.70 mm, measured according to the method mentioned above. It is made of 100% pure PVC, without any mineral filler; otherwise, it would not be transparent.




