

REFRESHER for lacquered floors

WOOD ACCESSORIES - PRODUCT INFORMATION

Tarkett Refresher cleans, protects and reinforces the varnish on your wooden floors.

- The Refresher for lacquered floors gives a new fresh appearance to the surface and removes microscratches.
- The Refresher is suitable for both domestic use and for public environments where floors are exposed to severe wear.
- The treatment is simple, quick and involves no expensive preparations or cleaning.
- Unlike normal polishes, the Refresher contains no wax to make the floor slippery and this also means that the treatment can be repeated frequently without building up thick layers.
- Use in concentrated form.
- The treatment increases the gloss level and shine of the floor, especially on low gloss surfaces.
- Do not use Refresher on newly installed floors.
- If the floor has been exposed to grease, floor soap, wax or polish, clean with an appropriate agent for removing this. Otherwise simply vacuum or dry mop the floor. Clean with a slightly damp microfibre mop. Use Tarkoclean or similar general purpose cleaner for floors. Then apply the Refresher in an even and thin layer using a very clean, damp microfibre mop. Follow instructions on the bottle.
- If the floor surface is exposed to road salt the floor must be wet mopped to remove this before applying the Refresher. The salt may otherwise react chemically with the Refresher and form a milky white surface.
- A floor treated only with the Refresher can be varnished again without removing the Refresher but the floor must always be sanded slightly before re-varnishing. It can also be damp mopped or cleaned with Tarkett's general purpose cleaner Tarkoclean between each treatment without dissolving the Refresher.
- How often you need to apply the Refresher depends on the degree of wear and tear of your floor. Below are some rules of thumb for cleaning intervals.

Shake the bottle well before use!

Heavy wear	e.g. shops	1 - 4 times a month
Medium wear	e.g. offices	1 - 3 times every three months
Light wear	homes	Once or twice a year

Tools	Microfibre mop
Coverage	1 litre will cover approx. 65 m ²
Drying time	Leave to dry for around 30 minutes before using the floor. Can be sensitive to moisture for the first two days after application.
Storage time	24 months in unopened bottle For opened bottle: Always make a small test in a corner before use.
Storage	Sensitive to frost. 10 - 30° C recommended.
Fire hazard	Non-flammable
