

# Tarkett Lino Floors

## Linoleum floors - homogeneous construction with xf<sup>2</sup> surface protection

The selected flooring, similar to **Tarkett Lino**, belongs to the Lino floors category under **EN ISO 24011 (EN 548)**, available in 2m wide sheet.

The product formulation must be mostly with natural and renewable ingredients such as linseed oil, pine rosin, wood and **cork flour** and calendered on jute, in a **homogeneous structure to grant longer durability**.

The selected flooring must be **free of formaldehyde, without phthalate, 100% REACH compliant and 100% recyclable**.

The selected flooring must be protected with a factory applied surface treatment with extensive durability and a reduced maintenance for high cost-effective flooring, like **xf2**.

The selected flooring must be covered by a **third-party verified Cradle to Cradle® certification**, with at least a **Silver** level, ensuring **design products** to positively contribute to the **environment and people's well-being** at each step of the product's life, while supporting the transition to a **circular economy** business model.

The selected flooring must be covered with a **10 Year Warranty**.

### HEALTHY MATERIAL

The selected flooring must be covered by a **third-party verified ingredient disclosure and material risk declaration down to 0.01%**, thus ensuring compliance far beyond REACH regulation requirements, such as **Material Health Statement (MHS)** delivered by the Environmental Protection Encouragement Agency (EPEA).

The selected flooring must be covered by a **third-party test to certify** optimal indoor air quality with **TVOC emissions ≤10µg/m<sup>3</sup>**.

The selected flooring must be covered by a **third-party test to certify its naturally anti-bacterial properties** and **must be approved by Allergy UK** ensuring hygienic environments in public buildings.

### SUSTAINABILITY CREDENTIALS

The selected flooring must be covered by a **specific third-party verified Environmental Product Declaration (EPD)**, disclosing among other indicators the **carbon footprint** of the flooring during its whole lifecycle (production, construction, use and end-of-life). The 2,5mm must be **carbon negative** (stages A1÷A3) like our **Lino 2,5 mm**.

Complementary options of the selected flooring must be:  
-Acoustic options : on **foam backing** giving a impact sound reduction of **19 dB** or **cork backing** giving **15dB**.

-Technical options: **Bfl, Conductive, R10, non-PU surface protection (like Essenza+)** and also **wall covering Bd2-D0 (Like LinoWall)**
